NOTRE DAME PREP

Tucson Service Trip: November 3rd – 5th, 2022

Day 1

Scottsdale – Tucson | Thursday, November 3

The team will meet at Notre Dame Prep at 8 am. We will depart at 8:30 am and begin the adventure by private bus. Einstein's Bagels will be served for breakfast. On the way, the team will stop at a local Bashas grocery store for a team shopping experience that includes purchasing grocery and food items for the Community Food Bank of Southern Arizona. All expenses for this experience will be covered by K2 Adventures Foundation. Immediately following the shopping adventure, the team will drive to the food bank to volunteer and make a donation of all the food items purchased.

Lunch will be served at the food bank. Following lunch, the team will take a tour of the Community Food Bank's resource center and participate in educational training. The team will spend the rest of the afternoon working at the food bank.

In the late afternoon, the team will depart the facility and check into their hotel. Dinner will be served at the hotel.

In the evening, there will be a movie shown about spreading kindness through acts of service, as well as reflections and a debrief of the day. Lights out and bed checks will be conducted by the trip chaperones.

Accommodations

Doubletree Suites by Hilton Tucson Airport. Accommodations will include rooms with 2 beds and a pull out couch. Sleeping accommodations will be 2-3 students per room and will be determined by NDP staff.

Day 2

Tucson | Friday, November 4

The team will wake for an early breakfast at the hotel and prepare for an 8:45 am departure for a day of service. The team will return to the food bank for a full day of volunteering. After a productive morning, lunch will be served.

After lunch, the team will work for a few more hours before returning to the hotel. An afternoon activity will be determined by NDP staff.

Dinner will be served at the hotel. In the evening, there will be a second movie shown, as well as reflections and a debrief of the day. Lights out and bed checks will be conducted by the trip chaperones.

Tucson - Scottsdale | Saturday, November 5

The team will wake for an early breakfast and prepare to depart the hotel at 8:45 am for a final morning of activities.

Trip Cost

- Round trip private bus to/from Notre Dame Prep High School
- All activities as listed in the itinerary to include:
 - 2 days of Community Service at a local food bank
 - Educational team activities and daily reflections (coordinated by NDP staff)
 - Team Hike
- Professional K2 chaperones with Wilderness First Responder certifications
