Navajo Nation Service Trip: October 26th – 29th, 2023

## Day 1

---

### Scottsdale – Bodaway Gap Chapter, Navajo Nation | Thursday, October 26

The team will meet at Notre Dame Prep at 8am to check in and begin travel to the Navajo Nation in private team transportation. Light snacks will be provided for the drive. On the way, the team will stop at a local Bashas' grocery store for a team shopping experience that includes purchasing grocery and food items for the residents of the Navajo Nation Bodaway Gap Chapter. All expenses for this experience will be covered by K2 Adventures Foundation. Immediately following the shopping adventure, the team will continue the drive to the Navajo Nation.

Upon arrival, the team will receive an introduction from the Bodaway Gap officials and staff and have lunch. After lunch, the team will distribute all of the food items purchased and begin their first round of service projects on the reservation.

In the late afternoon, the team will depart the reservation and check into their hotel. Dinner will be served at the hotel. In the evening, there will be reflections and a debrief of the day. Lights out and bed checks will be conducted by the NDP trip chaperones.

## Day 2

---

### Navajo Nation | Friday, October 27

The team will wake for an early breakfast at the hotel and prepare for an 8:30am departure for a day of service and cultural activities. The team will return to the Bodaway Gap Chapter and provide service work until lunch time. This work will consist of painting, trail grooming, weeding, garden maintenance and education. Students will be involved in all meal prep for lunch to be served onsite and will consist of a Frybread demonstration and preparation of Navajo tacos.

After lunch, the team will continue with service projects, along with additional activities to include local artisan workshops; ribbon skirt making, leather craft and beadwork, as well as learn how chapter members are able to be self-employed by the creation their artisan crafts.

In the late afternoon, the team will depart the reservation and arrive back at the hotel. Dinner will be served at the hotel. In the evening, there will be reflections and a debrief of the day. Lights out and bed checks will be conducted by the NDP trip chaperones.

### Navajo Nation | Saturday, October 28

The team will wake for an early breakfast at the hotel and prepare for an 8:30am departure for another day of service and cultural activities. Upon arrival at the reservation, the team will have a morning of service work, along with a cultural food experience consisting of sheep butchering, bread making and a cultural speaker on how the Navajo's utilize their land for food. After lunch, the team will spend the rest of the day doing service work, such as more trail grooming, repairing the livestock corrals and cleaning/organizing the Bittersprings' Home Association Office.

In the late afternoon, the team will depart the reservation and arrive back at the hotel. Dinner will be served at the hotel. In the evening, there will be reflections and a debrief of the day. Lights out and bed checks will be conducted by the NDP trip chaperones.

### \$945 per person

  - Number of service hours to be determined by NDP staff
