Sample Itinerary | 4 Days of Community Service / 2 days in Machu Picchu

Day 1

Arrive in Cusco

Arrive in Cusco (CUZ Airport), the ancient capital of the Incan Empire, elevation of 3,290 m (10,800 ft). A K2 representative will meet you outside of the airport and will be holding a K2 sign. Your private driver will then take you to the hotel for check-in. Rest and spend the remainder of the day at your leisure.

Overnight in Cusco, double occupancy.

Day 2

Cusco to Urubamba

Following an early breakfast, the team will check out of the hotel and begin their journey to Urubamba, located in the Sacred Valley of the Incas. Along the way, you will experience a tour of the archeological sites of Chinchero and Moray. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant, then the team will continue on to Urubamba where they will check into their hotel. Dinner will be served that evening at the hotel.

Breakfast, lunch and dinner included. Overnight in Urubamba, double occupancy.

Day 3

Urubamba

Following breakfast at the hotel, the team will depart for a day of community service. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant, then the team will return to the hotel for a team dinner.

Day 7

Urubamba to Aguas Calientes

After breakfast, you will take the train along the Urubamba River to Aguas Calientes, a small walking town built in the surrounding hillside of the Andes. Aguas Calientes, elevation 2,040 m (6,693 ft), is known as the gateway to the nearby Incan ruins of Machu Picchu. The town center is full of eateries and shops, anchored by the central Mercado Artisanal, a craft market filled with booths of brightly colored Peruvian souvenirs. After your arrival into the Aguas Calientes train station, you will be assisted with check in at your hotel. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant and you will have the rest of the day at your leisure. Dinner will be served at the hotel.

Breakfast, lunch and dinner included. Overnight in Aguas Calientes, double occupancy.

Day 8

Aguas Calientes

After breakfast, you will take a 30-minute bus ride to the entrance of Machu Picchu Citadel for a tour of Machu Picchu. After the tour, you will take the bus back down to Aguas Calientes and have the rest of the day at your leisure. Dinner will be served at the hotel.

Breakfast and dinner included. Overnight in Aguas Calientes, double occupancy.

Day 9

Aguas Calientes to Cusco

Today will be your second visit to the citadel of Machu Picchu and you will have the opportunity to climb Huchuy Picchu or Huayna Picchu Mountain. Afterwards, you will return to Aguas Calientes for lunch and you will board the train to travel back to the town of Ollantaytambo. The journey will continue by private bus through the Sacred Valley and if time allows, you will visit a local pottery shop, as well as a local farm, home to a furry herd of South American Camelids, better known as alpaca, llama and vicuña. The farm provides an opportunity to feed, touch and learn about the animals native to the Andes. Shopping for beautiful alpaca gifts is available on the property as well. You will arrive back in Cusco in the early evening. Dinner will be served at the hotel.

Breakfast, lunch and dinner included. Overnight in Cusco, double occupancy.

Day 10

Cusco

Following breakfast at the hotel, you will experience a city tour of Cusco, followed by lunch at a local restaurant. After lunch, the rest of the day will be at your leisure to explore Cusco. The team will reconvene for a celebratory team dinner at a local restaurant to include live music and dancing.

Breakfast, lunch and dinner included. Overnight in Cusco, double occupancy.

Day 11

Depart Cusco

Following breakfast and a leisurely morning in Cusco, you will return to the Cusco airport for your flight home. Private transportation will be provided as needed to the Cusco airport.

Breakfast included.

Cost Per Person Includes:

- All land travel, as stated in the itinerary in a private vehicle
- All hotel accommodations, double occupancy
- All meals, as stated in the itinerary

- All park fees and permits
- Professional, English-speaking local Peruvian guide(s)
- Tours and activities, as listed in the itinerary

Cost Per Person Does NOT Include:

- International airfare
- Travel, Medical and Evacuation Insurance
- All individual drinks, either non-alcoholic or alcoholic
- Personal gear and other personal expenses (laundry, room service, etc.)
- \$350 per person in tips for hotel staff, drivers and guides
- Subsequent lodging and food beyond the team itinerary
- Visa cost for international travelers. A visa is not required for U.S. citizens.
- Single accommodations are available for an additional fee
- Itinerary add-ons or customizations

If you are a single registering for one of our trips, we will try to accommodate you as a double with the same gender. However, if we are unable to make these arrangements, you may be responsible for the additional fee for single accommodations.
